
Adams, Jennifer. [Sense & Sensibility: an Opposites Primer.](#) (Board Book: BB ADA)

Arena, Jen. [Marta! Big & Small.](#) (E ARE)


In this story that incorporates Spanish words, Marta explores the world of opposites and animals.

Jeffers, Oliver. [The Hueys in What's the Opposite?](#) (Board Books: BB JEF)

Quirky egg-shaped creatures known as the Hueys explore the concept of opposites.



Jenkins, Steve. [Hottest Coldest Highest Deepest.](#) (Juvenile Non-fiction: J 910 JEN)

Describes some of the remarkable places on earth, including the hottest, coldest, windiest, snowiest, highest, and deepest.

While on a picnic, Bunny and Mouse see everything that happens to them from opposite points of view--Bunny sees only the good, while Mouse sees only the bad.




Meisel, Paul. [Good Night, Bat! Good Morning, Squirrel!](#) (E MEI)
